

GRANT/DONATION AGREEMENT

Dear Klaus Høm,

Biogen (Denmark) A/S is pleased to provide Scleroseforeningen with a grant of the amount of DKK 60.000 for the purpose of collecting knowledge on patient preferences on treatment within MS (the "Project").

We are writing this letter to formalize the terms of the Grant/Donation Agreement ("**this Agreement**") between

Biogen (Denmark) A/S, Ørestads Boulevard 67, 1, 2300 Copenhagen S, Denmark ("**Biogen**"),

and Scleroseforeningen, Mosedalsvej 15, 2500 Valby, Denmark ("**Institution**"), which are as follows:

1. The Purpose of the Grant

The Purpose of the Grant is to support the parts the project mentioned above (the Purpose") in accordance with the budget submitted with the grant request.

2. Name of the Grant

The name of the Grant is "Grant/Donation SCLEROSEFORENINGEN-002-2016"

3. The roles and obligations of the parties

Biogen is obliged to provide the Grant in the amount set out under section 5.

The Institution is obliged to ensure that the Grant is only used for the Purpose. Biogen must receive acceptable documentation for the use of the Grant for the Project. Any unused amount of the Grant must be returned to Biogen. Biogen will need documentation that the amount is transferred to a controlled account.

The Institution confirms and must ensure that the Grant is not used for entertainment of any kind (e.g. sporting, culture, music or leisure projects).

The parties confirm that to the best of their knowledge the Grant and the Project do not contravene statutory regulations of information on medicinal products and advertising as stated in the EU Advertising Directive, the advertising provisions of the Danish Medicines Act, and the Executive Order on advertising to the general public – as well as internal industry regulations. This Agreement does not provide any kind of exclusivity for the parties and any third party is free to sponsor the Project or other activities of the Institution.

4. Time frame

The Project will be carried out from October 2016 to March 2017.

5. Financial contribution

Biogen Idec commits to make a donation to the Institution in the amount of DKK 60.000 (the "Grant") excluding VAT.

The Grant amount will be transferred upon receipt of invoice with PO number 604732 into account 4440-4370210306 at Danske Bank under the control and audit of the Institution.

6. Non-financial contribution

There are no non-financial contributions from Biogen as part of the Project.

7. Publication

This Agreement will be available on Biogen's website, www.biogen.dk, for at least 2 years after the Project together with a list of the value of the Grant to the institution. A copy of this Agreement will continue to be available on request to Biogen for 10 years after the Project.

8. Independence and Compliance

The Institution confirm that receiving this Grant in no way influences the commercial operations, in particular the procurement transactions of the Institution nor are there expectations of said influence.


